
I would like to commend Keewatin Publications for the fine work you have done in the production of the Biodiversity magazine.

Thanx!!Strengths - visuals, up to date info, readable text, unique sections for each province at back, charts/graphs/etc, Canadian focus Could be improved - some pages are a bit text dense, page numbers would be helpful, I will be using the information with my grade 10 (Senior 2) students - Ecology section of General Science curriculum and my grade 12 (Senior 4) students in the Ecology section of the Biology curriculum. I know I will use the Number of species worldwide section for sure! (Love the pyramid chart!) The pyramid of biomass and global distribution of biomass pages will be useful. Ecozones of Canada, species of Canada, and the Manitoba sections will be used. It is great to get local and Canadian information in such beautifully laid out and colourful displays.

I still have a difficult time getting Canadian and local information on the Biotechnology industry in Canada. We do an extensive unit on Genetics, and there is lots of info, but none particular to research, jobs, etc. being conducted in Canada. (Manitoba I know has a huge biotech industry, but there is little out there for student use.) Also, I have the same concerns with weather topics. Hello Walter: I have been perusing the Biodiversity publication, and see a possible graphical conflict on page 11 (Global Distribution of Biomass). The "bell curve" labelling leaves the impression that the South Pole is on the wrong side (as labelled) in addition to the two mid-latitude Tropics. Could this be reversed for your electronic copy that is hosted at web sites, Walter? The rest looks great !
